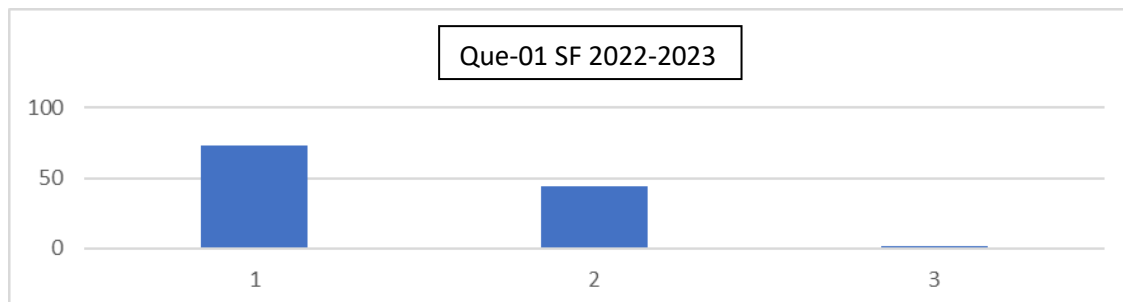

❖ Feedback Analysis through Graphical Representations and Relevant Action Taken Report:

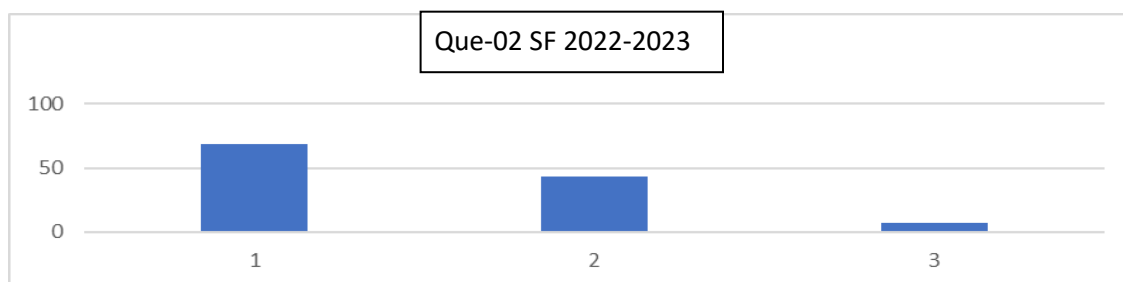

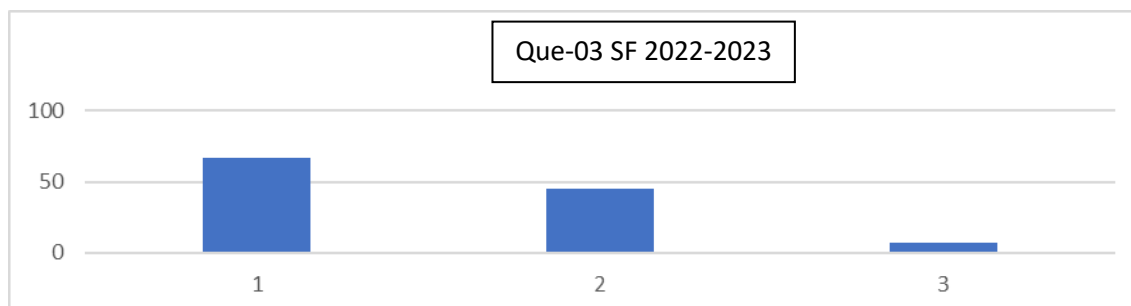
